- (i) **The agent :** The agent causes the disease & the cause of the disease. The agent is a microbe.
- (ii) **The host :** Usually humans or animals which are exposed to and harbour a disease.
- (iii) **The environment :** The external factors that cause or allow disease transmission due to favourable surrundings external to the host that allow the disease to be transmitted.

- **28.** (i) Cut is an injury which forms an opening in the skin.
  - (ii) (a) **Minor cuts :** Caused by sharp tools i. e. scissoer, regors, knives, pruners etc.

**First aid :** Clean the cut with clean water & then with salvon, apply antibiotic ointment & apply first aid bandage.

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- (b) Deep cuts : These expose the underlying tissues & cause heavy bleeding.
  First Aid : Stitching of tissues may be required. Tetanus toxioid injection should be given to prevent tetanus. 1
- **29.** (i) Rabies may be caused by non-immunized dogs bite.

- (ii) **Symptoms :** Skin break, puncture, cuts, bleeding, swelling & reduess of the area, oozing of fluid & in rabies, hydrophobia occur.
